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Introduction

Thank you for your participation in the Study UK Virtual Fair Pakistan, Nepal, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka on 10 October 2020.

The Study UK Virtual Fair was the first of its kind virtual event held across 4 markets in south Asia. The British Council Study UK Virtual Fair provided an exclusive opportunity for UK HEIs to participate and share information with students from Pakistan, Nepal, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka. The representatives from UK Higher Education Institutions met with over 2,500 potential students virtually and briefed them on the opportunities available for them in the UK.

The purpose of this report is to provide you with a summary of the event, including visitor and exhibitor feedback along with other useful information. Highlights:

- The Study UK Virtual Fair was first of its kind at the British Council that was held at the regional level.
- 4,500 prospective students, parents, faculty members registered for the virtual fair and over 2,500 attended the event on 10 October 2020.
- All exhibitors and participants adhered to British Council's Child Protection, Equality Diversity
 & inclusion (EDI) and Safeguarding policies
- 30 Meeting rooms were set up on Zoom (27 for UK HEIs, 1 for UKVI, 1 for IELTS and 1 for British Council IES (International Education Services) Team).
- An exclusive web page was set-up on British Council Pakistan website, from where students were guided to different meeting rooms.

Marketing and Promotions:

- The Study UK Virtual Fair was promoted internally through IES databases of students, counsellors, agents and parents in four countries, IELTS partners, Partner School Global Network (PSGN), local HEIs researchers and partners
- The Study UK Virtual Fair was also promoted through facebook, Instagram and Google across all four countries and It reached 13.8 million impressions.
- A video montage representing all UK HEIs was also generated and promoted across social media channels.









- 67% of the delegates thought that the quality of the participants was either excellent or very good while 29% thought it was good. 81% of the delegates thought the quantity of the participants was either excellent or very good.
- Almost 7 in 10 people rated the quality of the platform (Zoom) as excellent or very good, while almost 9 in 10 delegates were happy with the length of the event.
- 90% delegates rated the level of information and communication provided by the British Council before the event as excellent or very good.
- 24% delegates rated the Study UK Virtual Fair as excellent while 71% rated it as a very good event

- Over 89% attendees said that they have acquired new knowledge and/ or skills after taking part in this Study UK Virtual Fair
- 90% attendees rated the Study UK Virtual Fair as a high-quality event.



British Council recommendations for UK institutions

Participants and visitors are invited to share feedback and suggestions to help us make the event better for everyone involved. Given below are a few points for consideration based on an analysis of feedback shared by different stakeholder groups.

- For online platforms, it is vital for UK HEIs to be able to talk to multiple students simultaneously, therefore, the HEI's should bring at least 3-4 members for such event. These could be Alumni members, staff, current students or agents. This will enable the UK HEIs to manage multiple breakout rooms smoothly.
- We felt that on the day a few of the staff members from UK HEIs were not too comfortable with Zoom Online platform. For the success of the event and to avoid any technical issues on the day, the UK HEIs should attend the technical training sessions.
- In order to help us provide the best of arrangements to all participating institutes, we request institutions to please share relevant documents and information within deadlines. This helps us in providing further improved logistics and communication plans.
- Many students sought to receive career linked advice about the courses being promoted and we feel alumni can contribute in this area as well.
- Queries about scholarships are frequent and common. Several UK institutions have scholarships for Pakistani students; however, students are not too aware of these opportunities.
